THE EXPERIENCE

Fernando de Noronha is a dream place, or better put, a dream island. There, verdant mountains descend to sheer cliffs, which in turn fall into wide untouched sandy beaches. Beneath the waves live corals and colorful fish, manta rays, and lemon sharks. By the thousands, sea turtles lay eggs on the beaches facing out toward the Atlantic Ocean. And then there are the spinner dolphins. Early in the morning, in a bay called Baía dos Golfinhos ("Dolphin Bay"), spinner dolphins gather in pods of more than 1,000 to play and spin in the morning sunshine. Come afternoon, they set off on a daily circuit around the main island. Noronha was Brazil's first national marine park. All of the water and 70% of the land in and around Fernando de Noronha island is a national park, managed by the Brazilian environmental agency, IBAMA. Development is strictly controlled, and visitors must pay a daily fee, which is used to support environmental preservation. Despite the rules, there is plenty to do on Noronha. The archipelago is the best diving spot in Brazil, and one of the best in the world. It's also known as a hot spot for surfing. Visitors can also rent dune buggies and explore the island's pristine beaches.

In the past, people tried to escape Noronha. From the 17th to the 20th century, Fernando de Noronha served as a political prison. This 21-island archipelago sits way out in the Atlantic Ocean, 360 km (223 miles) from Natal, 545 km (337 miles) from Recife, and 2,600 km (1,612 miles) from the African coast. Between the 1940s and the 1980s, the island was under the direct control of Brazil's armed forces, which used it both as a base and a prison. It was not until 1988, when much of the island was incorporated into the new marine park, that Fernando de Noronha met its destiny as a sought-after tropical paradise.

SUGGESTED ITINERARY

DURATION: 5 DAYS/4 NIGHTS

Day 1 – Fernando de Noronha

Arrival at Fernando de Noronha. Transfer in a private car to your hotel. Check-in and accommodation.

Meals: (No meals).

Day 2 – Fernando de Noronha

After breakfast, a full-day tour through the island. Feel the island, get to know its history and stories, beauties, people and culture. In a private vehicle (buggy), enjoy only the best that Fernando de Noronha has to offer visitors. The exclusive bilingual host will guide you on a unique experience through the beaches, the historical center, the harbor and the trails; always with quick stops for photos or a break for a cooling swim in strategic spots. There is a pause for lunch, which is not included. We provide a cooler with cold water during the tour. Feel free to take your own beverages.

Meals: Breakfast.

BEST TIME TO VISIT

Fernando de Noronha is an all-year-round destination, but the best time to visit the islands and to fully enjoy their attractions is the dry season: from August to January. Fernando de Noronha's climate is tropical with two well-defined seasons: the dry season, mentioned above, and the rainy season, from February to July. March through May is the rainiest period, with April being the month of most precipitation.



GETTING THERE

Daily flights to Recife (REC) and Natal (NAT) from almost any city in Brazil. There are also flights from Lisbon, Portugal, to Recife.

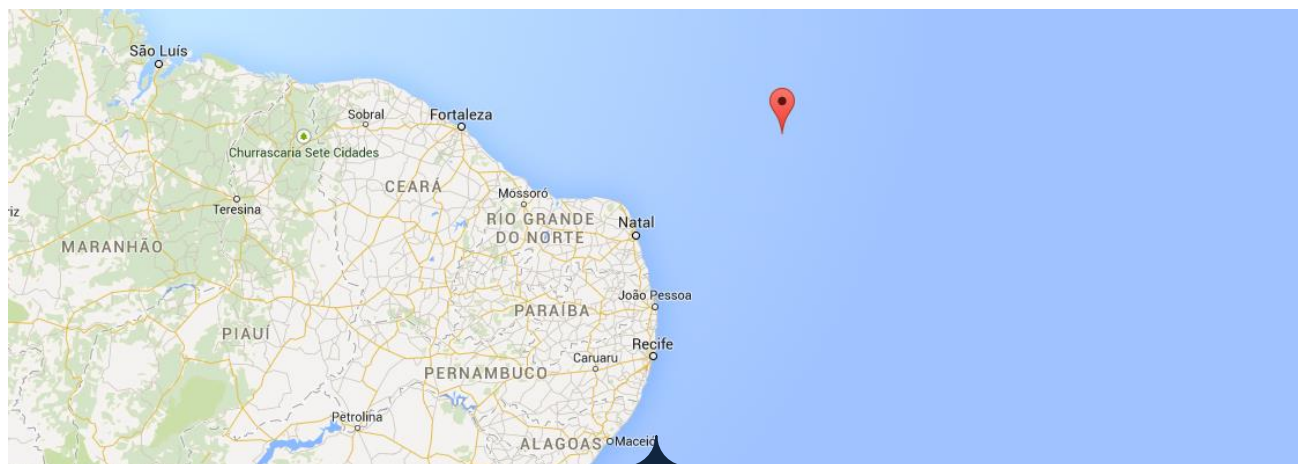

PAYMENT METHODS AND CANCELATION

CREDIT CARD (tax of 2,5%) OR WIRE TRANSFER

In order to secure a reservation, passengers must pay 30% of the total price of the trip via deposit up to 90 days prior to the departure date. Reservations made under 90 days before the departure date will result in the payment of the full cost of the trip upon purchase. The following credit cards are accepted: Visa and MasterCard.

Note that:

- Payments with credit cards are processed in Brazilian Reais with a tax of 2,5% percent.
- Payments via wire transfer are converted from Brazilian Reais to US Dollars at the exchange rate of the day of the transaction.

CANCELATION POLICY

- 10% fine on the amount paid if the cancellation occurs at least 30 days before the beginning of the trip.
- 20% fine on the amount paid if the cancellation occurs during the following period: 30 to 21 days before the beginning of the trip.
- If the cancellation occurs less 20 or less days before the beginning of the trip, there may be a fine greater than 20%, calculated upon proof of Auroraeco incurred expenses.

IMPORTANT

- Our prices are subject to change according to availability and time of year. They are not valid for national holidays, Carnaval and New Year.
- The itinerary may vary according to the need for operational changes, which can be caused by factors such as climate and availability.
- There will not be a refund or discount due to overnight reductions, once the check-in is made.
- Upon confirmation of the trip, a Medical Form and a Responsibility Term will be sent to all travelers, and should be filled in, signed and sent back to Auroraeco at least 30 days prior to the start of the trip. If there are less than 30 days between the dates of purchase and departure, please send the above mentioned documents as soon as possible.
