THE EXPERIENCE

Discover the famous Pipa Beach on top of a bike. Let the sea inspire you to pedal harder on top of the cliffs or through the sand. For relaxation, swim in a dark pond- you will feel like your diving into Coca-Cola. Exercise all you can, but don't give up the comfort provided by the best hotels in the area.

ITINERÁRIO

DURATION: 4 DAYS /3 NIGHTS

Dia 1 – Pipa

Reception at Natal airport. A private car will pick you up at your arrival terminal and take you to your hotel at Pipa Beach. The ride will last approximately 1 hour. Take care of your check-in and accommodate yourself in the hotel.

Meals: (No meals).

Dia 2 – Pipa (Sibaúma, Catu River and kayaking)

After breakfast, we'll bike through the beach to reach Sibaúma, where the ocean meets the Rio Catu (Catu River). Enjoy a swim in the natural pools. We'll continue west by bike along the river and cross shrimp farms to get to the waterfront restaurant Camarão da Fazenda for lunch. Next, take a kayak ride through the river and observe the rich and varied local flora and fauna (duration: 40 min). At the end of the kayak ride, our bikes will be waiting for us to go back to Pipa through the Route of the Cliffs.

Meals: Breakfast and lunch.

Accomplished: 17 km pedaling + 3 km kayaking.

Dia 3 – Pipa (Formosa Bay and Estrela farm)

After breakfast, we take buggies to Formosa Bay (20 km), a beautiful beach south of Pipa. We then start cycling in the park of Mata Estrela (Atlantic Forest Reserve), then we ride 4 km amongst large trees and vines that hang from them. See monkeys and other local animals. Visit an ancient tree and do like the indigenous people: walk inside it and make a wish. Back on our bikes, we'll ride through Estrela Farm, surrounded by coconut tree groves, until Barra do Cunhaú, where we'll take a ferry to reach our lunch break destination – a typical local restaurant – and later we head back to Pipa.

Meals: Breakfast and lunch.

Accomplished: 13 km by bike.

Dia 4 – Pipa

After breakfast, transfer to Natal airport at designated time. You will reach the airport in approximately 1 hour.

Meals: Breakfast.

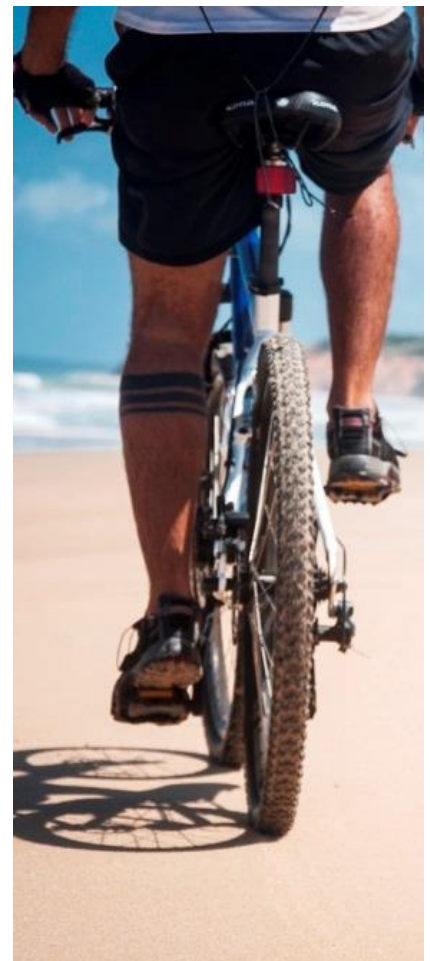
BEST TIME TO VISIT

The region can be visited all year round. Between the months of April and June, there are showers and cooler temperatures. In September, the wind is stronger and ideal for activities such as kitesurfing and sailing.

Daily flights to Natal airport (NAT). After that, 1-hour transfer to Pipa Beach.



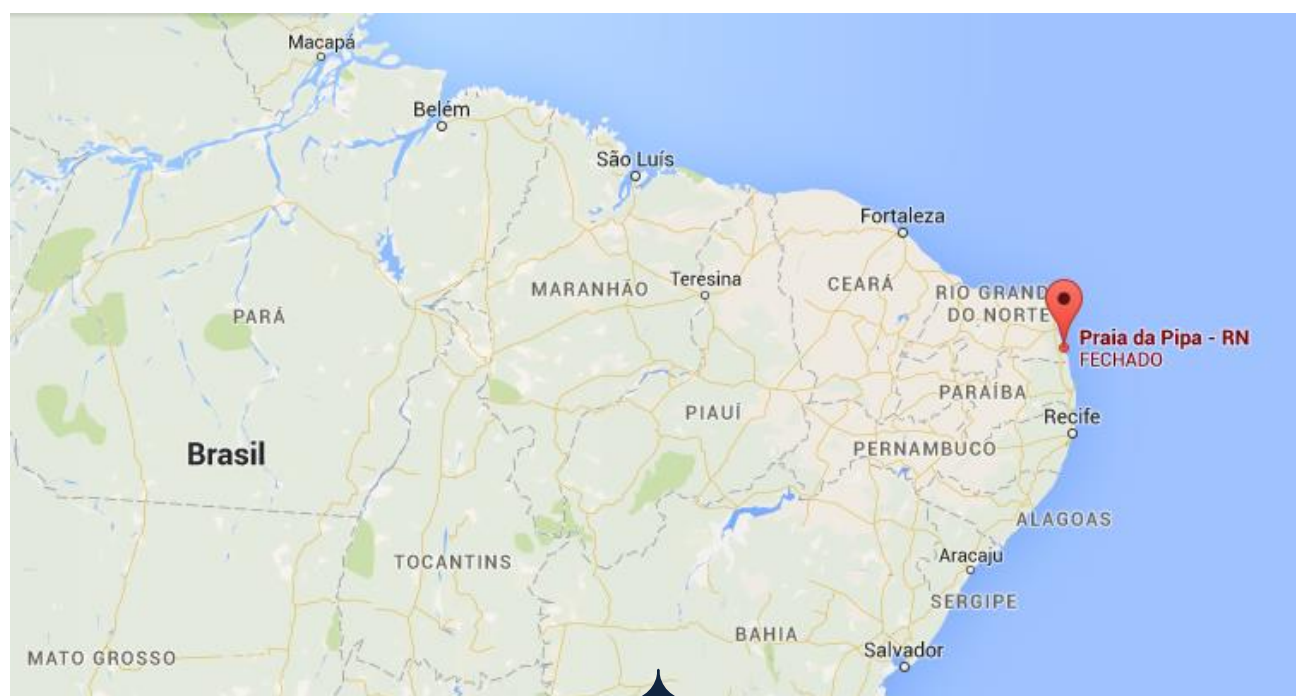

PAYMENT METHODS AND CANCELATION

CREDIT CARD (tax of 2,5%) OR WIRE TRANSFER

In order to secure a reservation, passengers must pay 30% of the total price of the trip via deposit up to 90 days prior to the departure date. Reservations made under 90 days before the departure date will result in the payment of the full cost of the trip upon purchase. The following credit cards are accepted: Visa and MasterCard.

Note that:

- Payments with credit cards are processed in Brazilian Reais with a tax of 2,5% percent.
- Payments via wire transfer are converted from Brazilian Reais to US Dollars at the exchange rate of the day of the transaction.

CANCELATION POLICY

- 10% fine on the amount paid if the cancellation occurs at least 30 days before the beginning of the trip.
- 20% fine on the amount paid if the cancellation occurs during the following period: 30 to 21 days before the beginning of the trip.
- If the cancellation occurs less 20 or less days before the beginning of the trip, there may be a fine greater than 20%, calculated upon proof of Auroraeco incurred expenses.

IMPORTANT

- Our prices are subject to change according to availability and time of year. They are not valid for national holidays, Carnaval and New Year.
- The itinerary may vary according to the need for operational changes, which can be caused by factors such as climate and availability.
- There will not be a refund or discount due to overnight reductions, once the check-in is made.
- Upon confirmation of the trip, a Medical Form and a Responsibility Term will be sent to all travelers, and should be filled in, signed and sent back to Auroraeco at least 30 days prior to the start of the trip. If there are less than 30 days between the dates of purchase and departure, please send the above mentioned documents as soon as possible.
