THE EXPERIENCE

Paraty, also spelled Parati, is a lovely colonial town, 125 miles from Rio de Janeiro, in Ilha Grande Bay, Brazil's southeastern coast. It's a favorite with Brazilians and visitors who want to get away from it all in a historic town, laze on one of the many beaches, and indulge in a restful or even active vacation.

SUGGESTED ITINERARY

DURATION: 4 DAYS/3 NIGHTS

Day 1 – Paraty

Arrive at the airport in Rio de Janeiro and transfer to Paraty (approximately 5 hours). Check-in at the hotel. Late afternoon/early evening, take a walking tour through Paraty's historical center escorted by your local host. At the Cooking School of Paraty, you will enjoy a unique dinner, preceded by demonstrations carried out by international chef Iara Roberts, in her kitchen. She will present a singular proposal of Brazilian cuisine, with dishes from Amazonas, Bahia and Minas Gerais, among others. During demonstrations, the Chef shares not only stories, but also the cultural aspects of each region, explaining the origins of ingredients, their nutritional value and influences on the cuisine. The chef takes every opportunity to teach cooking techniques and professional tips.

Meals: Dinner.

Day 2 – Paraty

After breakfast, take a regional vessel to explore Paraty's bay. Quick beach stop, and lunch at Ilha do Algodão. In the afternoon, we continue on boat and taste the most popular distilled alcoholic beverage in Brazil, Cachaça, at Cachaçaria Maria Izabel. At the end of the day, return by boat to Paraty. This excursion takes about 5 hours.

Meals: Breakfast and lunch.

Day 3 – Paraty

After breakfast, transfer (30 min) to Laranjeiras and hike the Praia do Sono trail through the Nature Reserve of Cairuçu. The walk takes about one hour and a half and starts with a short incline through the lush forest, where it is possible to admire different types of vegetation and birds. A quick stop along the way to refresh yourself in a beautiful waterfall before you reach Praia do Sono, one of the best beaches in Paraty.

After this climb, the hike becomes a lot less demanding. It is the only difficult part of the walk. We successively pass the beaches Antigos e Antiguinhos before arriving, an hour and a half later, at the fishing village of Ponta Negra. Lunch in a rustic restaurant at Praia do Sono. Finally, hike back to Laranjeiras and transfer to the hotel.

Meals: Breakfast and lunch.

BEST TIME TO VISIT

Paraty can be visited all year round. The region's winter temperatures stay around the 70's°F/20's°C, dipping occasionally below 60°F/15°C. Avoid mid-December onwards and January (rainy season). The best months for visiting are February, March, April, May, August and September.



GETTING THERE

Daily flights to Rio de Janeiro international airport (GIG). Next, a 5-hour transfer to Paraty.





Day 4 – Paraty

After breakfast, check-out and transfer to the airport in Rio de Janeiro (approximately 5 hours).

Meals: Breakfast.

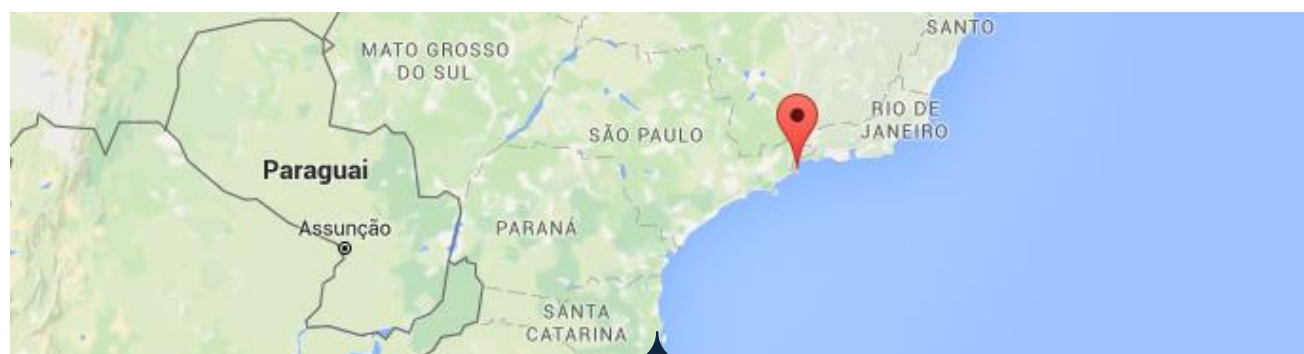

PAYMENT METHODS AND CANCELATION

CREDIT CARD (tax of 2,5%) OR WIRE TRANSFER

In order to secure a reservation, passengers must pay 30% of the total price of the trip via deposit up to 90 days prior to the departure date. Reservations made under 90 days before the departure date will result in the payment of the full cost of the trip upon purchase. The following credit cards are accepted: Visa and MasterCard.

Note that:

- Payments with credit cards are processed in Brazilian Reais with a tax of 2,5% percent.
- Payments via wire transfer are converted from Brazilian Reais to US Dollars at the exchange rate of the day of the transaction.

CANCELATION POLICY

- 10% fine on the amount paid if the cancellation occurs at least 30 days before the beginning of the trip.
- 20% fine on the amount paid if the cancellation occurs during the following period: 30 to 21 days before the beginning of the trip.
- If the cancellation occurs less 20 or less days before the beginning of the trip, there may be a fine greater than 20%, calculated upon proof of Auroraeco incurred expenses.

IMPORTANT

- Our prices are subject to change according to availability and time of year. They are not valid for national holidays, Carnaval and New Year.
- The itinerary may vary according to the need for operational changes, which can be caused by factors such as climate and availability.
- There will not be a refund or discount due to overnight reductions, once the check-in is made.
- Upon confirmation of the trip, a Medical Form and a Responsibility Term will be sent to all travelers, and should be filled in, signed and sent back to Auroraeco at least 30 days prior to the start of the trip. If there are less than 30 days between the dates of purchase and departure, please send the above mentioned documents as soon as possible.
