The city is the capital of the homonymous state of São Paulo, Brazil's most populous and wealthiest state. SUGGESTED ITINERARY DURATION: 3 DAYS/2 NIGHTS

Day 1 - São Paulo (City tour and Terraço Itália)

Arrival at the airport followed by private transfer to the hotel. Later, take part in a 4-hour city tour. Visit Ibirapuera Par, where you will visit MAM (Modern Art Museum), Paulista Avenue, the city's most famous post card, and the historic center of São Paulo. Stop at Santo Grão for a delicious cup of coffee. Next, visit Beco do Batman. This place has walls entirely devoted to graffiti and has works by national and foreign artists. Transfer back to the hotel.

Enjoy the night at Terraço Itália, a rooftop restaurant considered one of the best and most traditional locations in the city. It specializes in Italian cuisine and is located in Italia Building. Enjoy the most beautiful view of the city's historic center. The restaurant has classic decoration and is divided into three spacious rooms and a bar. Located in downtown São Paulo, the past sets the tone. Buildings tell the history of the city and the country in the streets.

Meals: Dinner.

Day 2 - São Paulo (Municipal Market and cooking class)

After breakfast, visit the Municipal Market with a chef. There you can taste numerous fruits, vegetables, and regional delicacies. The chef will help you buy the ingredients to later prepare a wonderful lunch. Next, transfer to the chef's cuisine to prepare the meal with the expert's quidance. Finally, transfer back to the hotel.

Day 3 - São Paulo

Enjoy breakfast at hotel and a free morning. Check-out at noon. Private transfer from hotel to the airport.

BEST TIME TO VISIT

Visit São Paulo any time of the year. The winter is mild and sub-dry, and the summer is moderately warm and rainy. Fall and spring are transitional seasons. In summer (January through March), the mean low temperature is about 63°F and the mean high temperatures is near 82°F. In winter, temperatures tend to range between 52°F and 73°F.



PAYMENT METHODS AND CANCELATION

CREDIT CARD OR WIRE TRANSFER

In order to secure a reservation, passengers must pay 30% of the total price of the trip via deposit up to 90 days prior to the departure date. Reservations made under 90 days before the departure date will result in the payment of the full cost of the trip. The following credit cards are accepted: Visa and MasterCard.

Note that:

- Payments with credit cards are processed in Brazilian Reais.
- Payments via wire transfer are converted from Brazilian Reais to US Dollars at the exchange rate of the day of the transaction.

CANCELATION POLICY

- 90 or more days prior to the check-in date: full refund of payment.
- 89 to 61 days prior to the check-in date: 80% refund of payment.
- 60 to 30 days prior to the check-in date: 50% refund of payment.
- 29 days or less prior to the check-in date: no refund of payment.

IMPORTANT

- Our prices are subject to change according to availability and time of year. They are not valid for national holidays, Carnaval and New Year.
- The itinerary may vary according to the need for operational changes, which can be caused by factors such as climate and availability.
- There will not be a refund or discount due to overnight reductions, once the check-in is made.
